- 5-13-1: PURPOSE: The REC-1, Recreational Property District is established to provide for green space, parks, natural lands and recreational use of such space by the public or by private users.
- 5-13-2: **PERMITTED USES:** All uses listed below are permitted uses:
- A. Parks
- B. Walking, riding, or snow mobile trails
- C. Public or private playgrounds, lakes or pools
- D. Nature preserves or forest preserves
- E. Arboretum or floral gardens
- F. Natural prairies
- G. Buildings incidental to the use of any permitted use, including shelter houses, rest rooms, amphitheaters, meeting rooms, cooking facilities, fire places, and incidental sales.
- 5-13-3: **PROCEEDS OF OPERATIONS:** The proceeds of any admission charges, sales, or providing of food on any REC-1 property shall be limited to receipt by public agencies or not-for-profit groups and organizations. The receipt of proceeds of operation by any private person, company, corporation or other organization for profit is banned under REC-1 zoning.
- 5-13-4: CONCESSION CONTRACTS: Section 5-13-3 shall not preclude the authorization of concession contracts to private

persons, companies, corporations or other organizations for profit, if the owner of the property would be qualified under Section 5-13-3 and said owner receives a sum equal to twenty five percent (25%) or more of the profits of the proceeds of operation each year pursuant to written contract, a copy of which contract shall be filed each year by the first day of May of each year.

5-13-5: MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: No building shall be erected or enlarged unless the following minimum requirements are met:

Lot area: 1 acre
Lot width: 80 feet
Set backs: 25 feet

Set backs: 25 feet from all streets and

boundaries

5-13-6: MAXIMUM HEIGHT: No building shall be erected that exceeds thirty feet (30') in height.
